Prague is the capital and the largest city of the Czech Republic, situated in the middle of Bohemia on the Vltava River.

It saw its first golden age under the rule of Charles IV in the 14th century. Prague was, at that time, the third largest city in Europe and witnessed something of an explosion in construction: Charles University, the New Town, the Charles Bridge, and Saint Vitus Cathedral were all built during this period. It took the city 11 centuries to get the look we know today.

TDR is offering a limited number of bursaries for applications from researchers wishing to participate in the Global Evidence Summit, based on the following criteria:
